

Barry Crocker AM

Barry Crocker, internationally known Australia Icon, was awarded the Order of Australia in 1987 for services to the Australian entertainment industry. Barry has received numerous awards including four Logies (one being the Gold Logie for Most Popular TV Personality); two Entertainer of the Year Awards; four 'Mo' Awards; one 'Sammy' and a 'Penguin'; and thirty-three Gold Records.

Playing the iconic role of 'Barry McKenzie', He became an international star in The Adventures of Barry McKenzie and Barry McKenzie Holds His Own, Feature Films.

<u>Television highlights</u> include *The Barry Crocker Show* two years on Network Ten; *Barry Crocker's 'Sound of Music'*; and six years as the host of Seven Network's *Carols in the Domain*. In London he compered three ITV variety specials and three Eurovision specials for the BBC.

<u>Cabaret performances</u> include seasons at the <u>MGM Grand Hotel in Las Vegas</u>, <u>The Bonsoir in New York</u>, and the <u>Talk of the Town</u> and <u>Palace Theatres in London</u>. He also participated in a concert for UNICEF at the UN Headquarters in New York with Dame <u>Joan Sutherland</u> and <u>Richard Bonynge</u>, <u>directed by Sir Robert Helpmann</u>; and has appeared live across America in three <u>Jerry Lewis</u> Telethons.

<u>Theatre Performances</u> lead role as Jerry Ryan with Michelle Lee and Tommy Tune in the American production of *See Saw*; Scapino in J.C. Williamsons *Scapino*; lead role in *Mothers Day* (Social Security) with June Salter and Katy Manning; the Australian tour of *Barry Crocker's Banjo*- a one man show tribute to Banjo Patterson; the role of Frank in *Educating Rita* with Katy Manning; The Narrator in *The Rocky Horror Picture Show*. In 2004, starred as *Paddy O'Malley* in the Australian musical *Eureka* 2005, to the end of May 2007 he toured Australia and New Zealand playing the role of 'Lazer Wolfe' in Topols '*Fiddler on the Roof'*. In 'Donny Destry' Australian film *Razzle Dazzle*.

Barry was honored with his own <u>This is Your Life</u> tribute <u>Nine Network</u>, and performed the role of Judge Stephens in the critically acclaimed production of 'The Hatpin'.
